

STEAM Teacher Awards Regulations

Enacted: 2023.07.27.

Chapter 1: General Provisions

Article 1 (Name) The title of these awards called 「STEAM Teacher Awards」.

Article 2 (Purpose) This regulation has purpose of setting necessary matters to select and reward the teachers who have contributed to communication, collaboration, critical thinking, creativity, and cooperative problem solving using 4Dframe in science, technology, engineering, art, mathematics and other fields to create and develop a convergence science culture in accordance to Article 5, Article 5 of the Articles of Incorporation of 「Foundation for the Advancement of STEAM」.

Article 3 (Award holder) The holder of the award for STEAM Teacher Awards is the official host of 1) Foundation for the Advancement of STEAM 2) Teacher Forum. The official organizer is the host organization of the teachers' forum (hereinafter referred to as the "host organization") determined by the organizing committee of the International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference (hereinafter referred to as the "The Organizing Committee") hosted by the foundation.

Chapter 2 Category and Qualification

Article 4 (Award category) This award is awarded at the teachers' forum on the first day of the annual International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference, and awards are given in the following categories:

1. Program (STEAM Program) category
2. Project (STEAM Project) category
3. Field research (STEAM Action research) category
4. C-STEAM; Creativity, Collaboration & STEAM category
5. NGFSTEAM; Next Generation Frontiers of STEAM category

Article 5 (Qualifications for Award) The award winners are all individuals, organizations, and institutions that communicate in various ways with learners of all ages through convergence education using 4Dframe teaching aids, and the qualifications for awards are as follows:

1. STEAM Program: Those who have systematically contributed to the development of learning, experience, and evaluation activities of convergence education through various combinations of various unit activities

2. STEAM Project: Those who contributed to the development of convergence education project fields as a leader or member of team activities who participated in the entire process of planning, running, and evaluation for mid-to-long-term topic exploration
3. STEAM Action research: Those who practice convergence education for sustainable development according to various themes and methods in the field of convergence education such as school, home, or group.
4. C-STEAM; Creativity, Collaboration & STEAM: Those who have contributed to strengthening learners' future competencies through convergence education, focusing on critical thinking, communication, creativity, collaborative ability, and cooperative problem-solving skills.
5. Next Generation Frontiers of STEAM: Those who share experiences and reflective retrospectives of convergence education in all generations, from infants to high school students (K-12) and adults to seniors.

Chapter 3 Selection of Winners

Article 6 (Judging Committee) The Organizing Committee establishes the following judging committee to establish and operate all standards and procedures necessary for selecting and awarding STEAM Teacher Awards winners:

1. The Organizing Committee constitutes a judging committee of up to 7 members, including the chairperson.
2. The term of office of the judges is from the date of appointment to the date of the awards ceremony in the year.

Article 7 (Functions of the Judging Committee) The judging committee performs the following to select winners.

1. The Judging Committee evaluates candidates' qualifications and achievements.
2. The Judging Committee selects award candidates in the relevant categories, and if there is no qualified person, they do not select award candidates for the corresponding year in that category.

Article 8 (Closed judging process) All contents related to award judgment will not be opened, and no objections to the judging process will be accepted.

Article 9 (Announcement of Winners and Awards)

1. Candidates who applied for this award, the winners will be announced at the annual International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference Teacher Forum, award certificates and prizes, and send 「Notification of Award」.
2. This award is given by the chairman of the Organizing Committee, the head of the organization responsible for the annual International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference Teachers Forum, or a person authorized by them.

Article 10 (Awarding Day) The date of the award is the same day as the International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference Teachers Forum, which also serves as the Teachers Forum and Awards Ceremony.

Article 11 (Reward) The reward for each category of award is determined by the Organizing Committee and the host organization of the International Mathematical Science Creativity Competition & Conference Teachers Forum.

Additional rules

These regulations come into force from the date of promulgation.
